












Bike-Ped Infrastructure Desired?



Priority Indicators for Need Analysis

- Idea: Data-driven needs & measurable criteria
- Outcome: Priority list of areas and/or projects
 - ▶ Two step analysis
 - Using measurable criteria, identify hot spots of "need"
 - 2. Prioritize gaps in tiers
- Discussion: What factors do you think of as priorities for pedestrian infrastructure? Bicycle infrastructure?
 - How would you measure these factors?
