**Call to Order**

Chair Aida Copic called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m. After roll call was taken, it was determined that there was a quorum present.

**Review and Approval of TTCC Minutes**

**Keith Griffie, Bullitt County, made a motion to approve the minutes for the November TTCC meeting. Jim Silliman, Oldham County, seconded the motion. Motion carried with a unanimous vote.**

**Transportation Policy Committee (TPC) Report**

Andy Rush, KIPDA staff, reported on the November TPC meeting. No action was required.

**Public Comment Period**

Brian McAllister commented that the Area of Potential Effects for the US 42 One-Way to Two-Way Conversion project should include the Clifton Historic District to meet federal and state guidelines. Tom Springer of QK4 stated that a response to the comments received on the project has been drafted and is under review by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC).

**University of Louisville (UofL) Named a Top 100 Bicycle Friendly University**

Justin Mog of UofL discussed the award and the logistics of how UofL set up to be bike friendly. No action was required.

**TTCC Officers**

**Anna Barge, Oldham County Planning Commission, made a motion to elect Flannery O'Neil as Vice Chair of the TTCC. Keith Griffie, Bullitt County, seconded the motion. Motion carried with a unanimous vote.**

**Amendments to the FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Connecting Kentuckiana 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)**

SUBJECT: KIPDA Performance Management Plan (PMP) Safety Targets Update

FHWA requires that the MPOs that have chosen to set safety performance measure targets specific to their region, or choose to adopt the state's targets, do so on an annual basis. The set of five safety performance measures are collectively referred to as PM 1. More specifically, the five measures that FHWA prescribes are:

- Number of Fatalities
- Fatality Rate
- Number of Serious Injuries
- Serious Injury Rate
- Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries

MPOs must submit updated baselines and targets to their respective State DOTs for each of these five measures or choose to adopt the states' targets. These baselines and targets are required to be presented as five-year rolling averages. A baseline for each measure has been established for the five-year period from 2020-2024. Proposed targets for each of the five measures reflecting 2022-2026, the methodology for establishing these targets, as well as a summary of 2025 crash data in the KIPDA Region, will be discussed at the meeting.
