Planning Updates:

In January 2026 the Transportation Policy Committee approved the new goals and objectives for Moving Kentuckiana Forward 2050. KIPDA staff will provide the committee with updates for the remainder of the planning process. TPC will be asked to approve the final draft of the MTP update in February 2027.

Socio-Economic Forecasting:

KIPDA staff are currently in the process of gathering data from the American Community Survey and the Decennial Census for the socio-economic forecasting update in the MTP. We will be using trend analysis tools to predict population, household, and employment estimates from 2025 through 2050. These socio-economic estimates will be mapped and presented to county officials in working group meetings to collaborate using local feedback to ensure accuracy. A summary of the results of this analysis will be included in MKF 2050.

Outreach:

KIPDA Staff will begin outreach in March of 2026 at events and pop up locations through out the region to discover the priorities of the public through interactive means where participants will be asked which funding bucket they would choose if they had a theoretical \$100 to spend.
